1) First, set a password for the root user by the following command:

```
$ sudo passwd root
```

by default, the username of the user account is:

```
user name: user  
password:  
empty password
```

```
and for root user:  
username : root  
password :  
empty password
```

2) You can update the Emperor-os on live Mode by the following command:

```
$ sudo apt update
```

or

```
$ up
```

3) You can install the Emperor-OS on live Mode by clicking on the installation icon on the desktop.

Note 3

- 4) Using the Stacer and systemctl tool to control all services and start-up of applications.
Please disable and stop unnecessary or enable and start necessary services.

`$sudo stacer`
or
`systemctl`

5)using some pre-alias commands to speed up Linux commands.

Type alias command to see the custom Emperor-os alias command in terminal.

```
$ alias
```

for example: you can type:

```
up = sudo apt update
```

```
sy=sudo synaptic
```

```
fm=sudo thunar
```

6) There are some ways to find tools and access them:

6-1) press Shift + Space key to run the Ulauncher app to find every tools

6-2) Using App-Launcher menu that is on the top-left on the desktop.

6-3) Using the whisker menu that is on the top-right corner of the desktop

7) Using setting-menu that the icon is on the panel.
It is instead of settings

8) You can always use the background images which you can set an image by right-click on desktop and click on desktop settings .
